Please follow these simple rules to keep yourselves and others safe:

- **Do not use this equipment if you or any member of your household has coronavirus symptoms or are self-isolating.**
- **Retain 2m distance from other users.**
- **Give way at entry and exit points to those leaving the play areas.**
- **Please bring and use your own hygiene products to clean hands and equipment.**
- **Younger users must be supervised by an adult.**
- **Consumption of food and drink is not permitted.**
- **Please use the bins provided or take litter home.**
- **Please be patient and considerate of other users. If it is not possible to social distance while using certain equipment, please wait your turn.**
- **Consider coming back another time if the play area is too busy.**
