Minutes of the Puddletown area parish council meeting held on Tuesday 12th November 2024 in the Puddletown Village Hall. The meeting commenced at 7.00pm

1124-102. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies have been received from CLlr Green for personal reasons and accepted by all.

1124-103. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST AND DISPENSATION REQUESTS

No declarations or requests for dispensation were made. NB this does not preclude any later declarations.

1124-104. PUBLIC SESSION

One member of public (MOP) raised the following:

1. Concern regarding traffic entering the village at speed. Noting on the eastern gateway there are rumble strips and slow signs, however there is nothing like this at the western gateway to the village.

It was noted the Parish Council's previous efforts to address traffic concerns encountered significant challenges due to Dorset Council policies.

Dorset Council prioritise traffic calming measures in accident hotspots, which leaves other locations, even those with community-reported concerns, ineligible for intervention under the existing framework.

Should the Parish Council decide to pursue the installation of traffic calming measures independently, we would face a series of legal requirements. Furthermore, if these requirements are successfully met, the entire cost of the works would fall on the Parish Council, adding a large financial burden to the process.

The Parish Council continues to explore options to enhance road safety while considering the financial and procedural implications of such projects.

2. Wished to enquire about Parish Council grant procedures.

It was noted the Parish Council are not able to award individual's any financial aid. Any grant application must demonstrate a clear need for financial support to achieve an objective which will benefit the Parish or a large percentage of the parish. It was noted any application in excess of £500 should be presented to the Clerk before 1st November, so that the request can be incorporated into the budget proposal. It was noted, on this occasion the Clerk would be able to accept an application within the next couple of weeks as the budget will be presented to Council for final approval in December.

3. Stated they are investigating a revamp of the village information board.

This was noted.

4. 300 years ago, the then Vicar of Puddletown conducted a door-to-door survey in Puddletown and an idea has been raised to mark this occasion. More information including a possible grant request would be presented to Council in the forthcoming months.

This was noted.

5. It was requested that the Parish Council consider consulting the public in connection to street names for the new Wyatt Homes development.

The Parish Council approved a motion to move agenda item 1124-109d forward to allow discussion while members of the public were present.

The Parish Council reported that they had received communication from Wyatt Homes, indicating the developer's willingness to consider a list of street name suggestions submitted by the Parish Council. Dorset Council had also provided a list of potential street names previously presented for a prior Wyatt Homes development. It was noted that Dorset Council's guidance emphasises that street names should have a connection to the village and must not duplicate names already in use nearby.

During the discussion, a MOP shared that, historically, fields were often named after the individuals who worked them. The member offered to provide the Parish Council with access to a list of historical field names, which could potentially inspire street naming. The Council expressed their gratitude for this valuable contribution.

ACTION: Clerk to add the ratification of the Street Name list to a forthcoming agenda.

One MOP reiterated the earlier concerns about traffic, highlighting that speeding in Tolpuddle is particularly common during nighttime hours.

It was agreed the Parish Council would pass on the concerns raised to Dorset Council Highways.
